The *Argus* newspaper was a major newspaper in Victoria during the first half of the twentieth century.

This index is especially helpful in finding evidence for events that occurred during years not available from the Registry of Births Deaths and Marriages Victoria due to their privacy policy.

The ability to search on mother's maiden name in the birth notices makes this index especially useful.

**Bounty Immigrants to NSW 1828-1842 \$180.00**

Index to bounty (assisted) immigrants arriving in the Australian state of New South Wales between 1828 and 1842.

This index to and transcription of the Archives Office of New South Wales (now State Records NSW) microfilms # 1286-1349 on 64 reels of microfilm has been created by Marj Knight. These films relate to the assisted or bounty immigrants to New South Wales (NSW) from 1828 to 1842.

### **Marine Births, Deaths & Marriages. Victoria 1853-1920 \$204.00**

This CD-ROM is not your ordinary BDM index. While at first glance it appears to be standard, with an index to over 6000 births, deaths and marriages on board ships bound for Victoria (the "Marine Registers") searchable using the Digger(TM) software, the CD-ROM actually contains much more.

Each entry in the index is linked to a scanned image of the original entry in the Marine Register. The new *Digger(TM) with images* software included on the CD will display the appropriate certificate when you click on the desired index entry.

As if that wasn't good enough, some images contain multiple pages. Where the Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages had further documentation about an event, that was also scanned and included on the CD-ROM as extra pages "behind" the original registration entry.

### **Marriage Index. Victoria 1921-1942 \$204.00**

This index includes all marriages (over 300,000) registered between 1921 and 1942 in Victoria, including reregistrations, corrections and late registrations. A few marriage registrations from the 1870s, which were not sent in to the Registry until the 1930s, are included.

Tasmanian Miscellaneous Parish Records 1837 to 1953

An index to a miscellaneous collection of Tasmanian microfilms containing approximately 10,000 baptisms, marriages, burials and other records from Hobart and country Tasmania. Locations include St David's Hobart, Ross District, Dorset Mission, Port Esperance and Brighton.

Tasmanian Colonial Index 1816-1889; NFI 1792; NSW 1823-1848

This is a collection of over 89,000 individuals shown in various Tasmanian records loosely titled ML (Mitchell Library NSW) Tasmanian Papers represented by microfilms CY 11, 97, 367, 368, 878, 957, 958, 1273, 2142 and 2356. The entries relate to free citizens and convicts and is from material as diverse as jury lists, letter books, supreme court records, prisoners, musters, land grants etc and cover 1816 to 1889. Some records from Norfolk Island (NFI) and Sydney, Liverpool and Newcastle regions of NSW are included.

Tasmanian Colonial Collection 1803 to 1923

An index to a miscellaneous collection of information from Tasmanian microfilms. The list contains over 76,000 entries and includes such diverse material as Ships Officers' Exams, Army Records, Hotels and Licences, Immigration (both bounty and unassisted), Land Selections and hundreds of names of passengers leaving Tasmania for the mainland and overseas ports to name a few.

### **Tasmanian Federation Index Births 1900-1919 Deaths and Marriages 1900-1930 \$231.00**

Contains over 221,000 records of births, deaths, and marriages registered in Tasmania and includes war deaths(WW1) of those who enrolled in Tasmania to serve with the Australian Imperial Forces and who died in service. The Index was compiled by volunteers from the Tasmanian Family History Society Inc.

### **Tasmanian Pioneer Index 1803-1899 \$220.00**

An index of over 425,000 records of baptisms, births, deaths, burials and marriages in the Australia state of Tasmania between 1803 and 1899. Copies of the records indexed on this CD-ROM can be purchased from the Archives Office of Tasmania.

This Digger CD-ROM contains a corrected version of the records released for use with MS-DOS over ten years ago.

### **Australia. Victoria: Cheltenham Cemetery Headstones 1933-2000** \$44.00

This is an indexed transcription of the headstones at Cheltenham Memorial Park also known as Cheltenham New Cemetery. The cemetery, located in Melbourne's south-east, has about 16,000 headstones. The lawn section is not included.

Also present on this CD are photographs of sections of the cemetery, and of some notable gravestones.

### **Australia. Victoria: Federal Referendum 1899** \$120.00

Names and addresses of all Victorian voters in the 1899 Referendum on Federation. Listed in alphabetical order of surname, and includes the signatures of many voters.

Compiled from 1841, the Gazetteer has a comprehensive list of places with a brief description of each one. Several maps are included. Originally published as *A Geographical Dictionary or Gazetteer of the Australian Colonies* by William Henry Wells in Sydney in 1848. 530 pages.

Originally published as *The Parliamentary Gazetteer of England and Wales 1840-1*, London. A comprehensive list of places with a brief description of each one. 2,683 pages.

### **Ireland: History of Co Clare** \$50.00

Originally published as *The History and Topography of The County of Clare*, by James Frost, Cork 1893. Descriptions and illustrations of places and people are included. 754 pages.

If you have family lines that originate from County Clare, then this book is a real gem. Many families and events are mentioned, including those items many other books class as too trivial to include, such as who stole whose pig. Also helps when trying to determine how surnames changed under various English influences.

### **Ireland: Index to Baronies, Parishes, Towns and Townlands 1851** \$70.00

Based on the 1851 Irish Census, and originally published in 1861 as *General Alphabetical Index to the Townlands and Towns, Parishes and Baronies of Ireland*. This lists all known place names used in Ireland in 1851 giving map and reference details. 993 pages.

## Software

Runs directly from the CD-ROM, no need to install. There is no coverage for Ireland. There is no information on individuals. The user licence permits private research only. Commercial usage such as lookup or printing services are not permitted without prior arrangement with Archer Software.
